Founded in 1912, the Better Business Bureau is a private, nonprofit organization whose self-described mission is to focus on advancing marketplace trust, consisting of 106 independently incorporated local BBB organizations in the United States and Canada, coordinated under the International Association of Better Business Bureaus (IABBB) in Arlington, Virginia.

The BBB rating system relies on an A+ through F letter-grade scale. The grades represent BBB's degree of confidence that the business is operating in a trustworthy manner and will make a good faith effort to resolve any customer concerns filed with the BBB. The ratings system relies on a proprietary formula that takes into account 17 factors based on objective information and actual incidences of a business's behavior that have been verified and evaluated by BBB professionals.

A minority owned business, One Vision Productions is a client-focused multi-media company that concentrates on the development of powerful and creative productions throughout the U.S. The three-time International Videographer Award winners provide a one-stop shop that combines a client's vision with the creative work of their production team. One Vision Productions has fostered business relationships with multi-million dollar corporate, government and nonprofit organizations such as the Woodruff Arts Center, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Nash Management Group, and Sodexo, Inc.

Founded in 2004, One Vision Productions has successfully doubled its gross revenue from 2010 to 2012.
